Wood option: Walnut, White Oak, African Mahogany

Finish:	"Italian Fruitwood" on Alder, medium distress with hand planing and raw rush
	(shown on front of tear sheet)
	"Worn Ebonized Beech" on Alder, medium distress with hand planing and rush stained to match (shown on back of tear sheet)

Finish option: Any

- Rush option: Raw, Stained to match finish, Honey Seal
- UPH option: Loose down wrap seat and down fill back cushions, flat cOM: welt 4.5 yards plain
- VARIATION Ottoman, Dining Armchair, Side Chair, Bar Stool, Counter Stool, Settee, Bed
